



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Getting started

- Divide your students into teams (3-5)
- Register your team on robotevents.com
- Purchase robot kit from kiwibots.co.nz
- Getting your students in engineering notebook from day one



During the season

- Register for scrimmage on robotevents.com
- Prepare for scrimmage
- Attend the scrimmage
- Work on robots and prepare again
- Attend more scrimmages

Awards

Qualifying and non-qualifying

Qualifying awards means the winner of the award is invited to the World Championship and is only available at National Championship

Performance or judged

A scrimmage's awards are posted in robotevents.com



Awards: TWO Excellence

- Judged award, goes to best all-around team,
- VIQRC: elementary, and middle school
- VRC: Middle School High School
- Prepare by:
 - Have a good robot
 - Practice judging
 - Compete in skills
 - Good engineering notebook





Awards: Teamwork challenge

- Performance award that goes to the alliance (2 teams) that wins the teamwork competition
- Usually a qualifying award for Worlds
- Prepare by
 - Building a good robot
 - Practice, practice, practice
 - Practice some more





Awards: Robot Skills

- Performance award, goes to team with best Robot Skills score
- Highest Robot Skills score wins the award
- Skills ranking is important



Awards: Design

- Judged award, goes to team with the best DOCUMENTED engineering design PROCESS
- Possible qualifying award for Worlds
- Prepare by:
 - Practice judging
 - Have great engineering notebook, kept up since first day
 - A team will NOT win this without a great notebook
